What are Mini-Grants?

ReACT provides mini-grants for tobacco prevention at the community level throughout Montana. It's competitive, so make yours awesome! A panel of judges' review and score mini-grant proposals based on application requirements. Selected applicants may receive full or partial funding for their project up to \$4,000. Currently, we support student-led activities and projects in the following areas:

1. Tobacco Product Campaign
 - a. Cessation
 - b. Difference between Commercial & Traditional Tobacco in the American Indian Community
 - c. Point of Sale
 - d. Inclusion of E-cigarettes in the Clean Indoor Air Act (CIAA)
2. Days of Action
3. Tobacco-Free Events

What Can You Do with a Mini-Grant?

- Park Clean Up
- "Truth About Vaping" billboard competition
- "Vaping Awareness" garbage decals
- "Vaping Prevention" social media campaign

How Can I Apply?

To apply for a reACT mini-grant, teens must collaborate with an adult (e.g., teacher, parent, school counselor, or local Tobacco Prevention Specialist) in their local areas. Applications are open to anyone in Montana, available annually, and can supplement youth tobacco prevention projects. Applicants can request up to \$4,000. It's competitive, so make yours awesome! Selected applicants will be awarded full or partial funding for their project up to \$4,000.
